Red Panda wants to think of words that end with *th*.



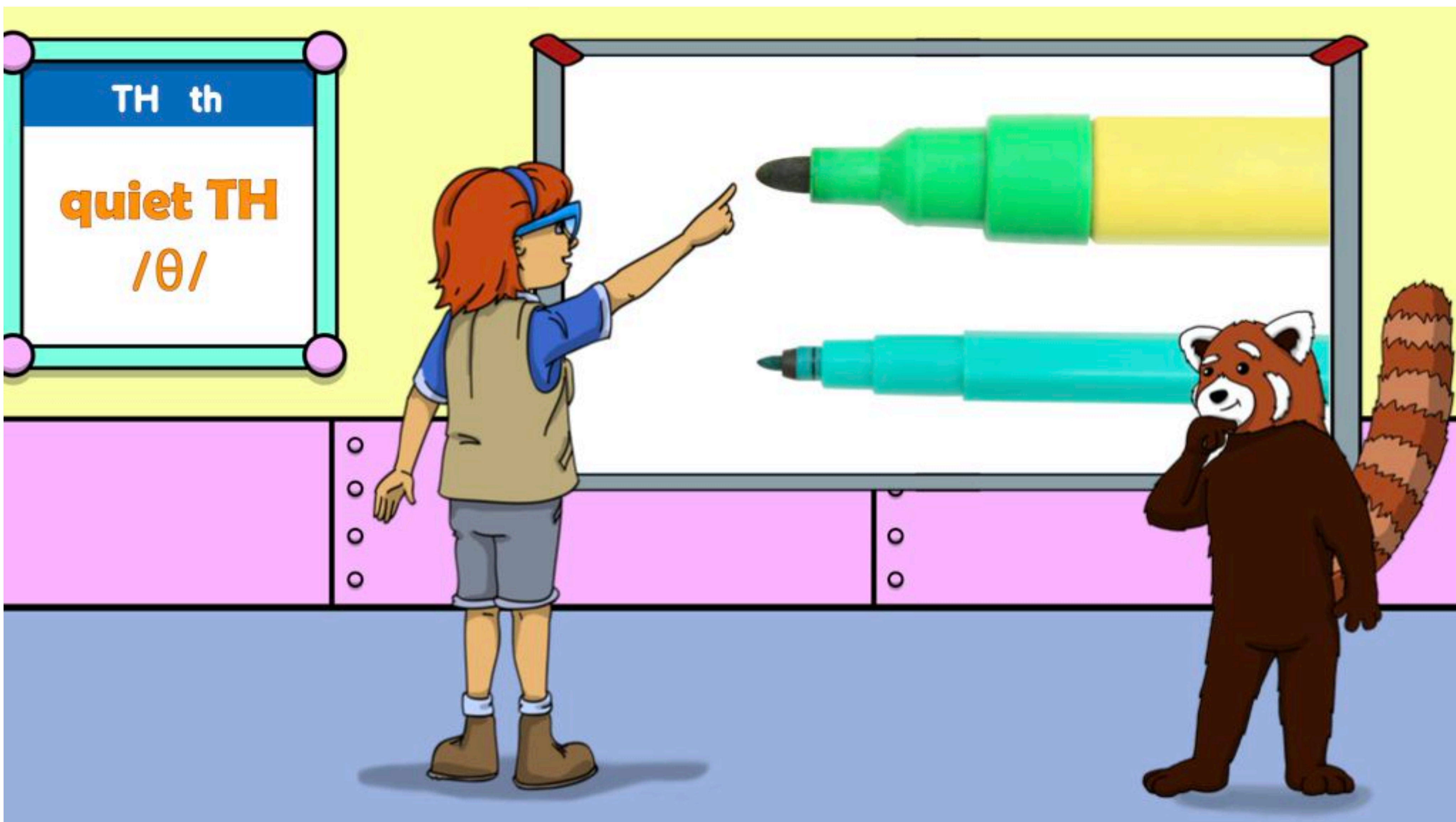
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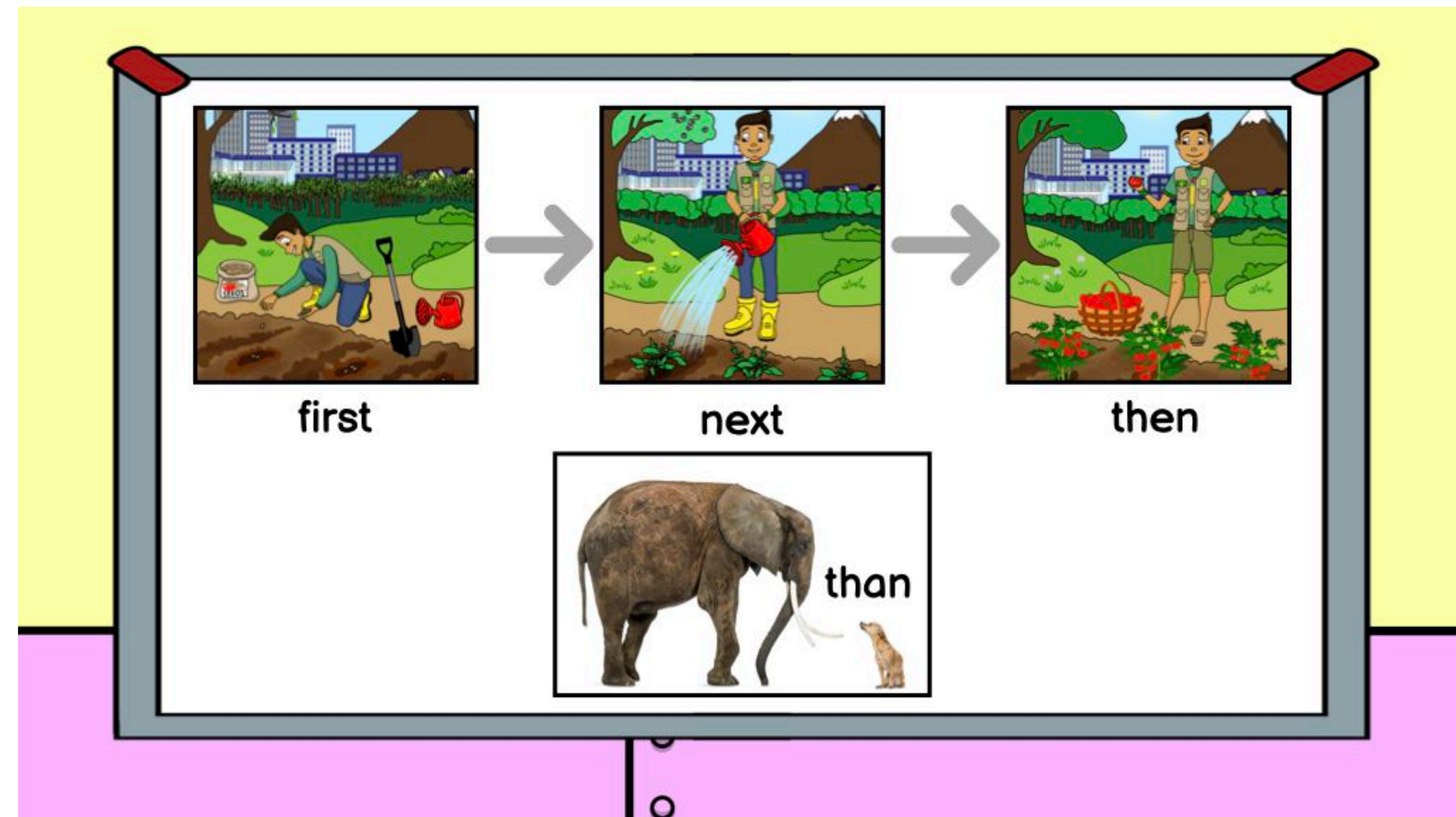
Deepa is here.
