Red Panda Conservation

Dear Friends of the Red Panda,

The World Wildlife Fund (WWF) is helping to save the Red panda. Almost half of all the Red pandas in the world live in the Eastern Himalayas. About 38% of the total Red panda habitat is in Nepal. The WWF keeps track of all the Red panda habitats. The loss of nesting trees is a big problem. The Red pandas don't have any place to live when their trees are cut down. Sometimes they get caught in traps that are meant for other animals. In some places they are trapped for their fur to make fur caps or hats. It is important that you tell people that we have to protect these animals and their habitat.

Deepa and Tim are planning a trip to the forest to observe Red pandas.




Deepa and Tim return to the forest. To protect the Red pandas, we have to stop people from cutting down all the trees. We have to coax people to take an oath to protect animals that are in danger of becoming extinct.



Deepa and Tim search for the Red panda in the forest. They want to observe Red pandas in their own habitat.



Deepa and Tim locate a Red panda. They put on their jetpacks and fly over to where the Red panda is dwelling.



After that, Deepa and Tim explain to the man about the Red pandas that live in the tree. The man listens and decides to help them save the Red pandas' home.



First, they rush down to the man with the ax.

Next, they yell "Stop!"

The man stops chopping the tree and waits.



Deepa and Tim reach a tree branch near the den of a family of Red pandas. They will observe them to learn more about the habits of Red pandas.



Tim peeks at the Red panda mom. She uses her bushy tail like a blanket to keep her cubs snug and warm.



A man with an ax is chopping the tree at its base. When the trees are gone, Red pandas lose their home. These Red panda cubs need help now. Deepa and Tim decide on a plan.



Tim and Deepa peek through the leaves to see what is happening. They can't ignore what they see. The life of the Red panda family is at stake.



Tim and Deepa watch the mother Red panda leave her cubs to seek food. The cubs are awake and playing in the den.



Deepa is thinking about the Red panda's size. Tim says, "A Red panda is about the size of a cat, but it has a very long and thick tail."

They see the mother Red panda approach a nest filled with eggs. She will snatch an egg to make a feast for her cubs.



All of a sudden, they hear a loud crack. The Red panda quickly races back to her den. Deepa and Tim wonder what they heard. What made the tree shake?
