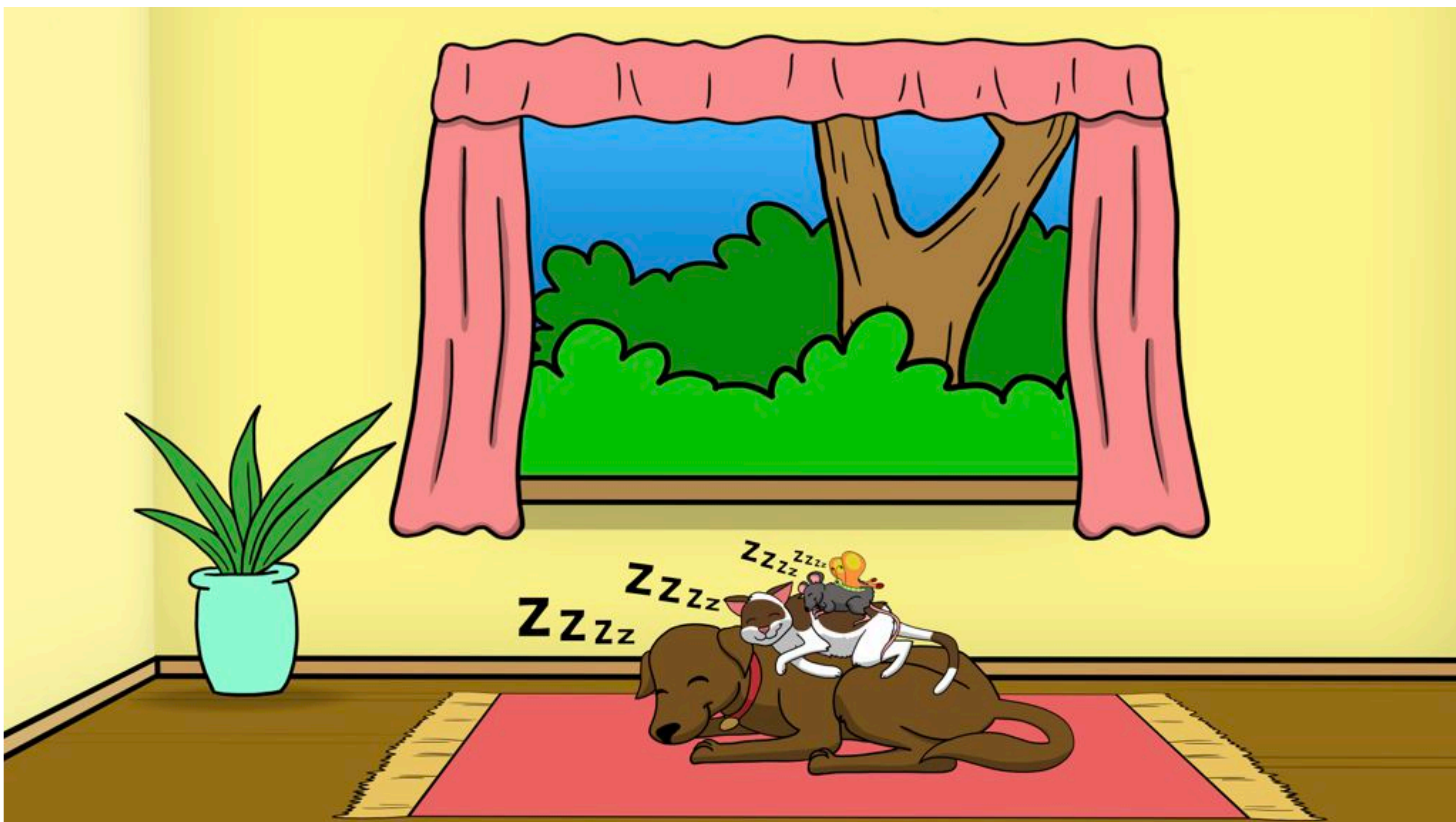
It is time for Pete, the dog, to take a nap. He settles down on the cozy pink rug and falls into a deep sleep. There is no one else at home.

So, the butterfly glides in and falls asleep on the mouse's spine.

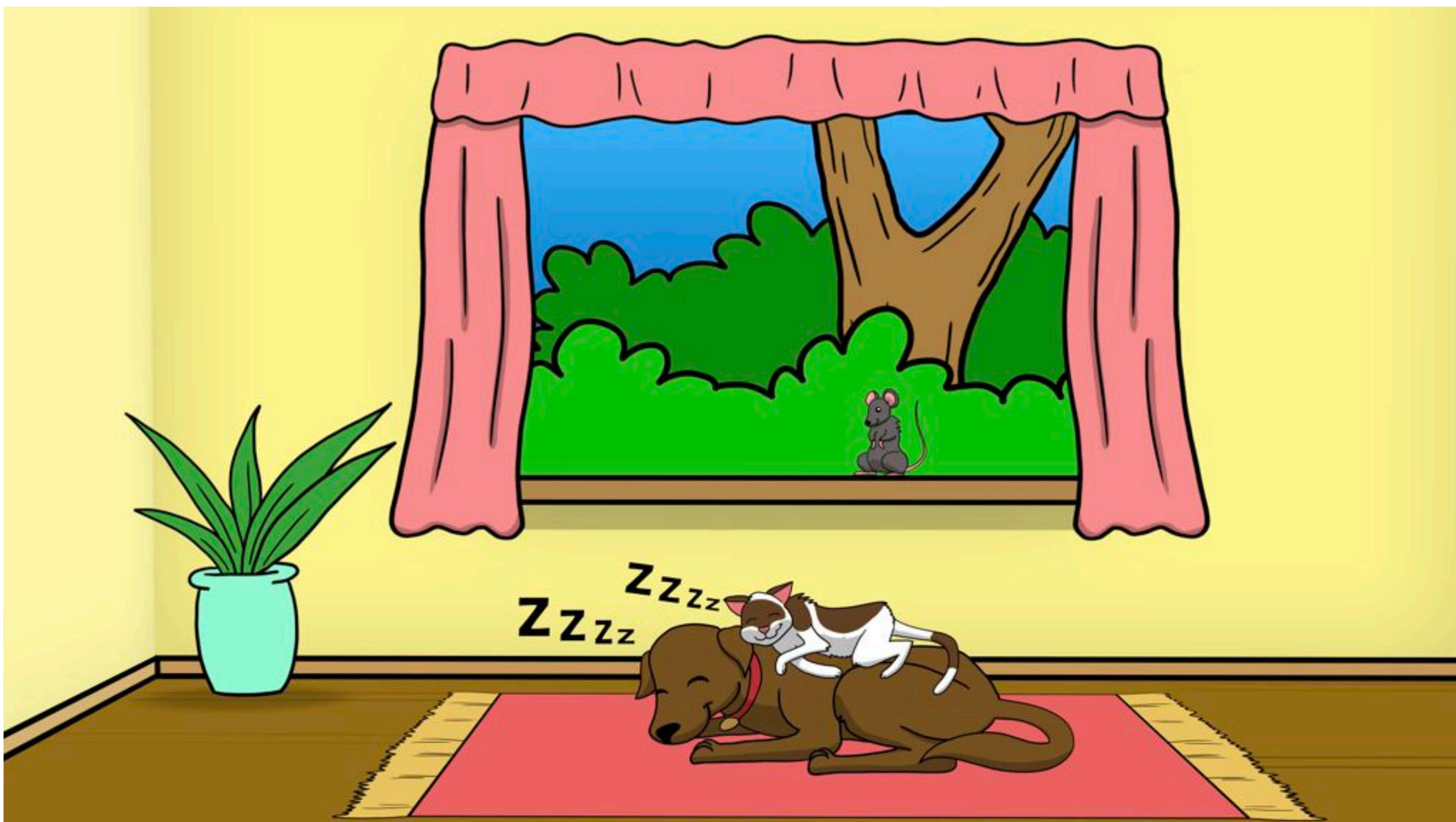
How nice and cute is this pile of nappers!

While Pete sleeps on the rug, a cat peeks in the window. The cat has a huge smile on its face.

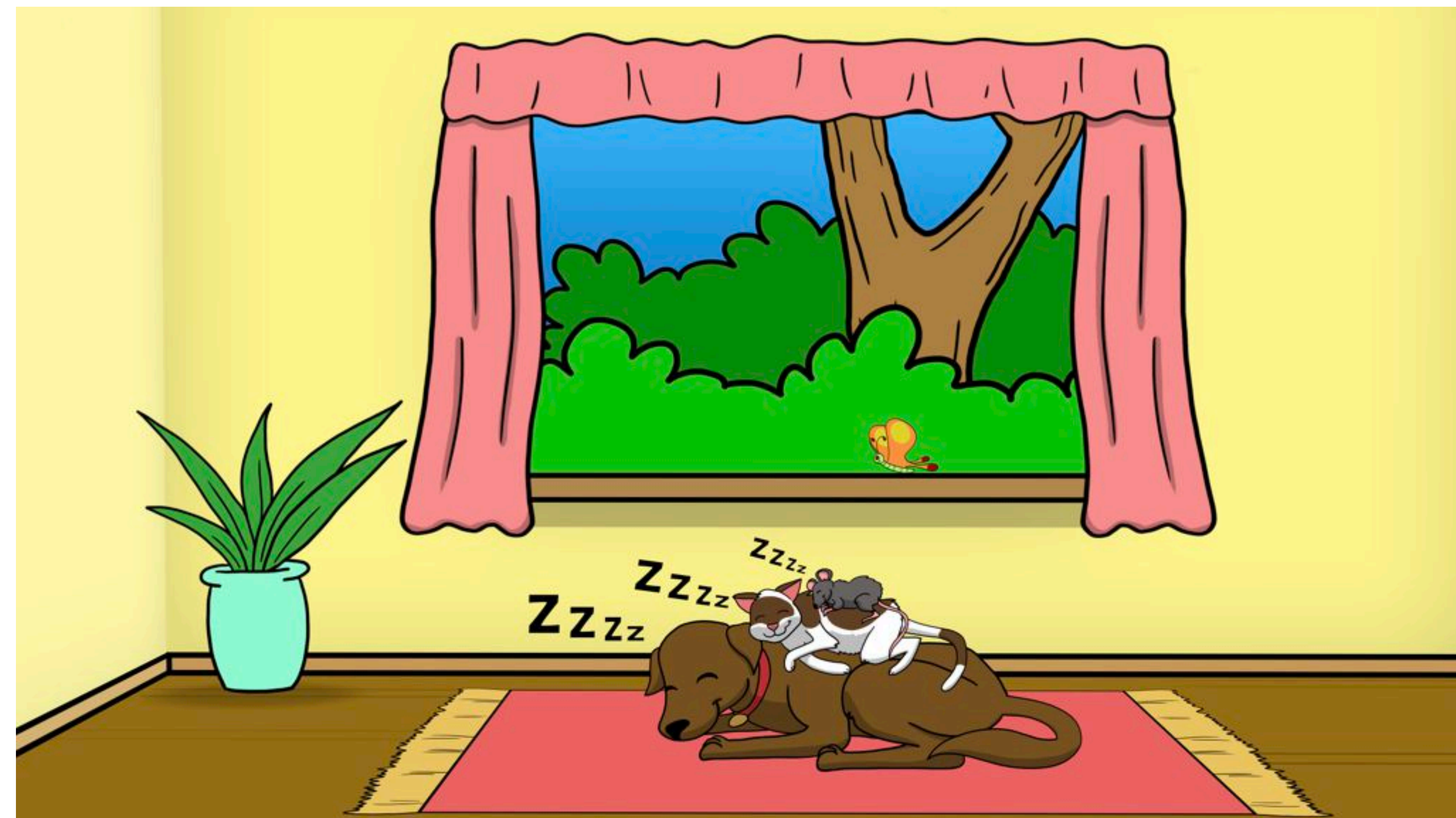
"It would be quite nice to have a doze, too," whines the cat.
